



APPLICATION OVERVIEW

Jose Amanujaq Kusugak dedicated his life to Nunavut and the advancement of Inuit rights. His passion and dedication to education and the promotion and preservation of Inuit language enabled Inuit to make many strides.

Nunavut Tunngavik Inc. (NTI) is ensuring Jose's ability to inspire Inuit continues through post-secondary education by awarding two annual \$5,000 scholarships to students pursuing post-secondary academic studies in the fields of education or Inuit language.

The period for applications is April 1 to July 9, Nunavut Day, each year.

Only those people awarded a grant will be contacted on the outcome of their application.

Students who wish to apply, but have not yet received a letter of acceptance or proof of enrolment from their academic institution may submit their applications, but must provide the acceptance and proof of enrolment before the fall semester begins.

The scholarship will be awarded in two, \$2,500 installments (September and January).

Students who do not complete the academic year for which they receive the scholarship will be required to pay back the amount received in full to NTI

Funds will not be dispersed to students until proof of enrolment is submitted once the September and January semester begins.

Once you complete your application form, use the checklist to make sure you have included all required materials.

You are eligible to apply for financial assistance if you are:

- A Beneficiary of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement
- Acquiring a skill or knowledge encompassing Inuit Qaujimaqatugangit, including but not limited to harvesting, sewing, learning Inuktitut/Inuinnaqtun
- Will be enrolled as a full-time or part-time student at a post-secondary level pursuing a certificate, trade, diploma or degree.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must write a 500-word essay that discusses in detail one of Jose Amanujaq Kusugak's many accomplishments.
- Applicant must clearly demonstrate how they will use and incorporate Jose's accomplishments and the advancement of Inuit rights into their education and studies.
- A copy of the acceptance letter from an accredited institution.
- Proof of enrolment at an accredited institution
- A completed application form.
- Two letters of reference from non-family members.
