The Plants & Flowers

The Plants spruce in the Kivalliq region Spring, Summer, and Fall season. The Tundra may be describe as treeless plain of three season spring, summer, and fall. The Ecological natural treed (forest) area is just southwest of Kivalliq region in distance, part of the Hudson plain in kilometres of the community. The Plants, and flowers in our region.

- Willow, Lyme Grass
- Tundra Poppy, Lichen, Moss
- Cotton, Cloudberry, Bearberry
- Mountain Avens, Purple Saxefrage etc.

The Habitat

The plants that grow, or branch on the tundra can be found in the Kivalliq region. The variety of habitat plant life can be found sprucing in many different shapes, or roots trailing on surface. The flowering plants starts to blossom spring during warm temperature climate.

The Berries

The Berries grow its seed when warm tropical climate occur on its natural everglade area that produces beautiful landscape of living plants. The Berries grow in low evergreen bloom areas of the tundra landscape upon plants of flowers, and soil branches. The Berries that produces seed on its ecological areas of its natural grasslands grow:

- Cloudberry
- Crowberry (Blueberry)
- Cranberry
- Arctic Blackberry

The Natural Eco-System

The Berries starts to seeds its best when warm, and moisture tropical climate occur of its natures harvest. The August to September plant life, or berries produces variety of its ripe natural ecosystem of its ripened berries that could be harvest for various recipes, as part of tradition.

The Freshly Harvested Natural Berries can be made into recipes i.e. jam, traditional Bannock, tea, or other mix delicacy, and homemade bakery etc.
