- Battery
- Propane Tank
- Tires, or Metal

The Municipality of Chesterfield Inlet encourage members to recycle unused dangerous goods i.e. Used Oil, Battery, Propane Tank, Tires, or Metal.

## TDG Dangerous Goods Regulations

The Transportation of Dangerous Goods recycle regulations, and guidelines. The regulations to certify recycle containers before shipment, and application. The Recycle Containers must comply:

- TDG Permit Certification Application
- Inspection on site of TDG Dangerous Goods
- Register Recycle Containers/ Shipment
- Recycle Services/ Companies Inc.

## Landfill & Metal Scrap Yard

The disposed materials/ products of autos, ATV/ snowmobiles, appliances, lumber, plastic, or tires etc. are composed on each separate area.



## Shipment of Dangerous Goods

The recycle containers must comply and certify under Transportation of Dangerous Goods services, and require inspection on site by certified dangerous goods inspector to comply TDG regulations before shipment. The containers must be registered before shipment with Nunavut Sealink Inc., or NEAS.
