This is a part time position for an individual who has graduated high school and who may or may not be interested in pursuing a further education or a career in research.

Responsibilities:

- Attend meetings via zoom when required
- Enter data into spreadsheets and make SIKU posts as required
- Willingness to interview community members as required
- Collaborate with the GENICE II team to plan and conduct research (e.g., supporting water sampling, soil sampling, travelling on land, interviews and workshops).
- Participate in data analysis and writing reports and peer reviewed research papers
- Complete required training (e.g., Human Ethics training)
- Assist GENICE II Research Team in the hiring locals for guiding, interpreting, or other tasks
- Travel within Canada may be required

Requirements:

- Must be between the ages of 18 to 30
- Must be resident of Chesterfield Inlet, NU
- High school diploma or equivalent
- Must have a valid ID
- Fluency in English is required (written and spoken)
- Inuktitut an asset
- Proficiency OR high drive to learn Microsoft Excel, Microsoft Word
- Must have a valid criminal records check
